

POOL RULES

*As a Member of Brock's Gap Swim Club,
You Can and Should Enforce the Rules.*

- Use is restricted to members and invited guests of the Brock's Gap Swim Club. A member must accompany all guests at all times.
- Members, their families and guests shall use the pool AT THEIR OWN RISK. THERE IS NO LIFEGUARD AT THE POOL.
- Members are limited to five (5) guests per member household.
- Anyone under 12 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible individual 18 years of age or older.
- No Business Activity in or around the pool area without express written permission from the Board.
- Safety Equipment should not be disturbed except in the case of an emergency.
- Shower before entering the pool.
- Please use towels to protect the pool furniture from sunscreen and oil.
- No diving.
- No running, pushing, foul language or general roughhousing. Please keep conduct in a manner suitable for a family environment.
- Please be considerate of others by not throwing hard objects, using large floats, or bringing water guns (i.e. super soakers, etc.) in the pool.
- Place trash in receptacles.
- No food or drink may be consumed while in the pool or within five feet (5') of the pool.
- Glass, sharp metal, or any other hazardous object is strictly prohibited within the pool area.
- No loud music. Only personal music devices with headsets or earphones are permitted.
- Swim diapers must be used at all times when necessary. Contamination of the Pool requires the pool be shut down for a minimum of 24 hours.
- No animals, skateboards, bikes or scooters allowed inside the fence.
- Appropriate swimming apparel only. No cutoffs.
- Persons with infectious health conditions are not permitted in the pool.
- The pool and the surrounding deck, awning/covered area, tables, etc. cannot be reserved at any time.
- DO NOT prop gate open and please close umbrella(s) when leaving.
- Pool users are expected to respect the pool facilities by helping maintain clean and sanitary conditions at all times. It would be helpful if everyone will use towels to protect the chairs from sunscreen and oil. This will help keep them looking new much longer.
- The Association reserves the right to deny use of the pool to anyone at any time.

VIOLATORS OF THE POOL RULES MAY RESULT IN AMENITY PRIVILEGES BEING REVOKED.
