

## TIMBERLINE 2013 POOL RULES

- **REPORT TO THE LIFEGUARD OR ATTENDANT BEFORE ENTERING THE POOL. NO SWIMMING UNLESS A LIFEGUARD IS PRESENT.**
- **Pool hours: *Hours are subject to change.***

### Beginning May 25th:

Mon – Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 pm  
Sundays – 1:00 – 7:00 pm

### Beginning August 4th:

Mon - Friday 1:00 pm - 6:00 pm  
Saturday 10:00 am - 8:00 pm  
Sunday 1:00 pm - 7:00 pm

### After Labor Day weekend - September 2nd:

Open only on weekends  
Saturday 10:00 am - 6:00 pm  
Sunday 1:00 pm - 6:00 pm

- Use of the facility requires an activated Members' card which are provided to each family and activated when their annual assessment has been paid. Residents of Timberline who are not paid members may not use the pool as a guest of another paid member.
- Immediate Family is designated as residents and children residing in the home. Guests must be present with the member at all times. Residents are responsible for the supervision and conduct of their immediate family and guests.
- There are a limited number of outside memberships available to members of the Timberline Golf Club and Timberline Homeowners Association.
- An adult resident must supervise minors under the age of 14 at all times.
- Members may not have more than ten guests unless they register with McKay Management. Parties with more than ten guests are not allowed on weekends (including Fridays) or holidays. Please see Rental Rules for instructions.
- Shower before entering the water.
- Non-toilet trained children and children wearing diapers are not allowed in the gated pool area unless they are wearing swim diapers. Any closure or disrupted use of the pool as a result of an accident caused by violating this rule may result in charges to include cost of treating the pool and prorated loss of use of the pool to the members.
- Persons with contagious or infectious health conditions are not permitted in the water, pool area or restrooms. Do not swim if you have diarrhea, as you can spread germs into the water and make other people sick. Any closure or disrupted use of the pool as a result of an accident caused by violating this rule may result in charges to include cost of treating the pool and prorated loss of use of the pool to the members.
- Inappropriate behavior is not permitted in the pool, poolside, bathrooms, or parking lot. No foul language is permitted on club property. No running, pushing, or general roughhousing will be permitted in or around the pool.
- No diving is allowed.
- No food or beverages are allowed in the pool. Eating and drinking are permitted on pool deck. The resident is responsible to remove all trash in trash containers before leaving the pool. No glass is allowed on the pool deck.
- No gum or tobacco products will be allowed in the fenced-in pool area or pool bathrooms.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the pool area. No person may enter or stay on the property in an intoxicated condition.
- Please monitor your children and insist they take bathroom breaks often. Wash your hands and your child's hands with soap and water before swimming.
- Conservative swimming attire (no thongs or brief Speedos) should be worn at the pool. No cutoffs or street clothing are allowed in the water. Diapered children are not allowed to enter the pool property wearing disposable or cloth diapers (Swim diapers only).
- Only personal music devices are permitted.
- Gates should never be propped open.
- No skateboards, bicycles or scooters are allowed inside of the fence.
- No animals are allowed inside of the fence.
- Safety equipment should not be disturbed except in case of emergency.
- Observance of lifeguard's instructions is strictly required. Disregard of lifeguard instructions may result in suspension of pool privileges.

**As a member of the pool, you can enforce the rules.**
